Our fully painted furniture collections are made from solid, new plantation pine and medium density fibreboard (MDF). This combination has proven to be strong, stable and an ideal substrate for painted finishes.

RADIATA PINE

New Zealand's soil and climatic conditions are ideal for growing very high quality Radiata pine which has fewer knots and is relatively free of internal defects and growth stress. One of the best clear-woods in the world, Radiata pine is a medium density wood which has a good finish when painted or stained.

MEDIUM DENSITY FIBREBOARD (MDF)

MDF is an engineered wood product that is often used in furniture manufacturing. It won't split or crack, and it is flexible, stable, strong, consistent, shapes well and is easy to finish with either paint or a veneer.

DISTRESSED FINISHES

Some of our painted finishes have been rubbed back in places to create an authentic 'shabby chic' look. This process is carried out by hand by our skilled craftspeople and therefore each piece is unique. Variations in the width, depth, colour and location of the rubbed back areas are to be expected and contribute to the product's charm.

CARING FOR PAINTED FINISHES

Howard Clean-A-Finish

Clean-A-Finish effectively cleans all timber surfaces using a traditional blend of gentle yet powerful natural soaps. It easily removes dirt and build up from furniture and is recommended for painted surfaces. It is non-toxic and biodegradable and does not contain any harmful chemical cleaning agents. Apply a light spray onto a soft cloth, not directly onto the surface of the timber.

Take care when using blue glass cleaners as they can stain painted finishes.



WARRANTY

When positioning furniture in your home, do not place it in direct sunlight, close to heaters or outdoors. Doing so can result in damage that is not covered by warranty. 1825 interiors warrants that our furniture collections with painted finishes are free from manufacturing, structural or materials defects for 12 months from the date of delivery.
